

**OFFICIAL RULES  
GIVE TWIN CITIES CHARITY CHALLENGE 2017  
BONUS CHALLENGES**

**NO PURCHASE OF ANY KIND IS REQUIRED TO ENTER OR WIN. A PURCHASE WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING. VOID WHERE PROHIBITED.**

**THESE OFFICIAL RULES CONTAIN AN ARBITRATION AGREEMENT, WHICH WILL, WITH LIMITED EXCEPTION, REQUIRE YOU TO SUBMIT CLAIMS YOU HAVE AGAINST SPONSOR AND/OR CROWDRISE (EACH, AS DEFINED BELOW) TO BINDING AND FINAL ARBITRATION. UNDER THE ARBITRATION AGREEMENT, (1) YOU WILL ONLY BE PERMITTED TO PURSUE CLAIMS AGAINST SPONSOR OR CROWDRISE ON AN INDIVIDUAL BASIS, NOT AS A PLAINTIFF OR CLASS MEMBER IN ANY CLASS OR REPRESENTATIVE ACTION OR PROCEEDING, AND (2) YOU WILL ONLY BE PERMITTED TO SEEK RELIEF (INCLUDING MONETARY, INJUNCTIVE, AND DECLARATORY RELIEF) ON AN INDIVIDUAL BASIS.**

**1. INTRODUCTION:** The Give Twin Cities Challenge 2017 Bonus Challenges (hereinafter, the “Bonus Challenges”) are a series of individual, separate promotions that occur during the course of the Give Twin Cities Challenge that are outlined in the schedule in Section 3 herein. The Bonus Challenges are sponsored by Minnesota Monthly (“Sponsor”) and administered by GoFundMe, Inc., (“Administrator”) which operates a crowdfunding platform called CrowdRise (“CrowdRise”). Minnesota Monthly (the “Prize Provider”) is responsible for providing the prize(s) for the Promotion. All of the Bonus Challenge descriptions, Official Rules, prizes, number of winners, schedule and all other information can be viewed herein and also on the CrowdRise platform here: <http://givetwincities.crowdrisetookit.com/bonus-challenges.html>. By participating in the Bonus Challenges, each entrant accepts the terms and conditions stated in these Official Rules, agrees to be bound by the decisions of the Sponsor and CrowdRise and warrants that such entrant is eligible to participate in the Challenge. To win the prize(s), you must comply with all facets of the Official Rules and all decisions by Sponsor and CrowdRise and the Official Challenge Rules which can be found here: [https://cdncustom.crowdrise.com/promo/OfficialRules-GiveTwinCitiesChallenge2017\\_v2.pdf](https://cdncustom.crowdrise.com/promo/OfficialRules-GiveTwinCitiesChallenge2017_v2.pdf) (herein after, “Challenge Rules”). CrowdRise’s computer is the official clock for the Challenge. Only entities that are approved by Sponsor will be able to participate in fundraising in the Challenge on the Website here and enter and compete in the Challenge and Bonus Challenges here: <https://www.crowdrise.com/givetwincitieschallenge> (the “Website”).

**2. ELIGIBILITY:** The Challenge and its Bonus Challenges are open to legal entities incorporated or organized within the 50 United States or the District of Columbia in any of the following categories (each an “Eligible Organization”): organizations located within and serving Minnesota that are a (a) tax-exempt entity recognized by the Internal Revenue Service under Section 501(c)(3) or an (b) organization with a fiscal sponsor that is a tax-exempt entity recognized by the Internal Revenue Service under Section 501(c)3; and SPECIFICALLY EXCLUDING THE FOLLOWING: (i) organizations that practice discrimination by race, creed, color, sex, sexual orientation, age or national origin; (ii) organizations that serve only their own memberships (such as those types of fraternal organizations, pageants, labor organizations or religious groups that do not provide services to persons who are not members (or relatives) of the particular group); and (iii) organizations affiliated with political parties, political candidates, lobbyist activities, political publications or political advertising. Without limiting the foregoing, Sponsor reserves the right, in its absolute discretion, to exclude any organization Sponsor determines is inappropriate for any reason. Two (2) or more charities that are distinct and have unique Tax IDs (EINs) or business numbers, as the case may be, may not share one Campaign page in order to increase their odds in the Challenge. If you are an individual agreeing to these Official Rules on behalf of a legal entity (“Representative”), you represent and warrant that (i) you are an authorized representative of such entity able to legally bind such entity and (ii) have read, and hereby agree to, these Official Rules on behalf of such entity. All entries made in connection with the Challenge are governed by these Official Rules and are subject to verification of eligibility before a prize is awarded. Sponsor and CrowdRise and their respective parents, affiliate companies, subsidiaries, agents, employees, independent contractors, officers, directors, advertising and promotion agencies and anyone involved in the development or execution of the Challenge, as well as the immediate family (spouse, parents, siblings, and

children and their respective spouses, regardless of where they live) and household members of each such employee, whether or not related, are not eligible to participate in the competition for the Grand Prizes and Bonus Challenges. All federal, state and local rules and regulations apply. VOID WHERE PROHIBITED BY LAW. Entries that are submitted in connection with the Challenge will only be eligible if (A) the entrant's Campaign, and related content posted by the entrant, does not contain content that is unlawful, hateful or obscene, in the Sponsor's and/or CrowdRise's discretion, and (B) the funds from the Campaign are being used, and will continue to be used, solely for the Purpose. The entrant is solely responsible for ensuring that donations raised are used in accordance with the organization's charitable mission.

**3. PROMOTION PERIOD AND DONATIONS:** The Bonus Challenges begin on July 20, 2017 at 11:00am CT and end on August 24, 2017 at 12:59:59pm CT (the "Promotion Period") and consist of multiple, separate Bonus Challenges as outlined in the Schedule below. Each has its own entry period, entrants, winner(s) prize and is an individual promotion. CrowdRise's server and computer clock is the official time-keeping device. If you enter via any free method described below, such entries must be received by CrowdRise before the end of the Promotion Period. If you enter by fundraising (i.e. receiving third-party donations as described below), such donations must be successfully processed to completion through CrowdRise and its third party payment processor(s) **before** the end of the Promotion Period. CrowdRise has the right to verify any such donation, and any such donation that is subject to chargeback or dispute is not eligible. **Donations can take time to process.** Neither Sponsor nor CrowdRise is responsible for any delays in processing any donations. The list of donations on any particular fundraising page, if any is displaying or any similar tally of donation(s), are unofficial tallies of the amounts of donations in a campaign and may not accurately reflect the donations made based on a variety of factors. Results of the Promotion are not official until CrowdRise or a duly authorized representative expressly announces the final results and verifies the winner(s).

**4. HOW TO ENTER AND WIN THE BONUS CHALLENGES:**

**BONUS CHALLENGE ONE:**

During the Entry Period, July 20, 2017 at 11:00am CT to July 25, 2017 at 12:59:59pm CT, each Eligible Organization can enter one (1) time by either of the following methods to be entered into a random drawing for a chance to win five hundred dollars (\$500). There will be two (2) winners.

**Method One:**

Fundraise at least five hundred dollars (\$500) in eligible monetary donations on the Website to your organization's Campaign. Each donation must meet all listed restrictions below in Section 5 to be eligible.

**OR**

**Method Two:**

**No Purchase Necessary to Enter or Win. You may enter for free.** Go to: <https://www.crowdrise.com/Challenge-FreeAlternateMethodofEntry> and follow the on-screen instructions to submit a "Free Alternate Method of Entry" form. The name of the Promotion is "Give Twin Cities Bonus Challenge One". Your form must be submitted and received during the Entry Period and must be complete and accurate, or your entry is automatically void.

**Limits:**

One entry and Prize per organization. Odds of winning in this Bonus Challenge depend on the number of Eligible Organizations who enter as described above.

Restrictions Apply (in Section 5 below).

**BONUS CHALLENGE TWO:**

During the Entry Period, July 25, 2017 at 1:00pm CT to August 1, 2017 at 12:59:59pm CT, each Eligible Organization should work to solicit as much in eligible monetary donations as possible on the Website to its Fundraising Page (each donation must meet all listed restrictions below to be eligible) and the Eligible Organization to fundraise the most dollars to its Campaign throughout the Entry Period will win a Challenge Grant of one thousand dollars (\$1,000). Each Eligible Organization shall keep the donations it raises, whether or not it wins a Challenge Grant. Potential Winners are not declared final and shall not receive a Prize until verified by Administrator. Winning a Challenge Grant is dependent upon Eligible Organization's fundraising skills.

Tie Breaker: In the event of a tie in the amounts raised by two or more Eligible Charities, the organization with the most donations will win.

**Limits:**

One entry and Prize per organization. If there are not a sufficient number of entries, not all Challenge Grants will be awarded by Prize Provider.

Restrictions Apply (in Section 5 below).

**BONUS CHALLENGE THREE:**

During the Entry Period, August 1, 2017 at 1:00pm CT to August 8, 2017 at 12:59:59pm CT, there is a Sweepstakes and a Contest, each a separate Promotion and you may participate, enter and win both. Each is described below.

**BONUS CHALLENGE THREE SWEEPSTAKES:**

**There are two methods of entry by which you may enter the Sweepstakes, including a free method of entry:**

**Method One:**

On every Charity Team page, there's a FUNDRAISE FOR THIS CAMPAIGN button on the right side of the page. With a click of a button a fundraiser or "Team Member" can set up and can help raise money for your cause before or during the Challenge. During the Entry Period, every Eligible Charity with at least five (5) Team Members that have raised money (any amount) (each an "active" Team Member) will be entered into a random drawing for a chance to win.

**OR**

**Method Two: (free method of entry)**

Eligible Charities can enter for free: go to <https://www.crowdrise.com/Challenge-FreeAlternateMethodofEntry> and follow the on-screen instructions to submit a "Free Alternate Method of Entry" form. The name of the Promotion is "*Give Twin Cities Challenge- Bonus Challenge Three Sweepstakes*". Your form must be submitted and received during the Entry Period and must be complete and accurate, or your entry is automatically void. Part Two: During the Entry Period, the Eligible Charity with the greatest number of Team Members that have raised money (any amount) (each an "active" Team Member) will win. Restrictions Apply (in Section 5 below).

### **BONUS CHALLENGE THREE CONTEST:**

On every Charity Team page, there's a FUNDRAISE FOR THIS CAMPAIGN button on the right side of the page. With a click of a button a fundraiser or "Team Member" can set up and can help raise money for your cause before or during the Challenge. During the Entry Period, the Eligible Charity with the greatest number of Team Members that have raised money (any amount) (each an "active" Team Member) will win.

### **BONUS CHALLENGE FOUR:**

During the Entry Period, August 8, 2017 at 1:00pm CT to August 15, 2017 at 12:59:59pm CT, each Eligible Organization should work to solicit as much in eligible monetary donations as possible on the Website to its Fundraising Page (each donation must meet all listed restrictions below to be eligible) and the two (2) Eligible Organizations to fundraise the most dollars to its Campaign throughout the Entry Period will win a Challenge Grant of three hundred dollars (\$300). Each Eligible Organization shall keep the donations it raises, whether or not it wins a Challenge Grant. Potential Winners are not declared final and shall not receive a Prize until verified by Administrator. Winning a Challenge Grant is dependent upon Eligible Organization's fundraising skills.

Tie Breaker: In the event of a tie in the amounts raised by two or more Eligible Charities, the organization with the most donations will win.

Restrictions Apply (in Section 5 below).

#### **Limits:**

One entry and Prize per organization. If there are not a sufficient number of entries, not all Challenge Grants will be awarded by Prize Provider.

**Bonus Rock, Paper Scissors Match for the Winners of Bonus Challenge Four:** After Bonus Challenge Four has ended, the two Winning Organizations will be entered into a Bonus Rock, Paper, Scissors Match hosted online over email by Administrator within 24 hours after the Bonus Challenge winners have been announced by Administrator. The winner of the Match will receive a Challenge Grant of seven hundred dollars (\$700).

### **BONUS CHALLENGE FIVE:**

During the Entry Period, August 15, 2017 at 1:00pm CT to August 22, 2017 at 12:59:59pm CT, each Eligible Organization should work to solicit as much in eligible monetary donations as possible on the Website to its Fundraising Page (each donation must meet all listed restrictions below to be eligible) and the two (2) Eligible Organizations to fundraise the most dollars to its Campaign throughout the Entry Period will win a Challenge Grant of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250). Each Eligible Organization shall keep the donations it raises, whether or not it wins a Challenge Grant. Potential Winners are not declared final and shall not receive a Prize until verified by Administrator. Winning a Challenge Grant is dependent upon Eligible Organization's fundraising skills.

Tie Breaker: In the event of a tie in the amounts raised by two or more Eligible Charities, the organization with the most donations will win.

#### **Limits:**

One entry and Prize per organization. If there are not a sufficient number of entries, not all Challenge Grants will be awarded by Prize Provider.

Restrictions Apply (in Section 5 below).

## **BONUS CHALLENGE SIX:**

During the Entry Period, August 22, 2017 at 1:00pm CT to August 24, 2017 at 12:59:59pm CT, each Eligible Organization can enter one (1) time by either of the following methods to be entered into a random drawing for a chance to win five hundred dollars (\$500). There will be one (1) winner.

### **Method One:**

Fundraise at least five hundred dollars (\$500) in eligible monetary donations on the Website to your organization's Campaign. Each donation must meet all listed restrictions below in Section 5 to be eligible.

**OR**

### **Method Two:**

**No Purchase Necessary to Enter or Win. You may enter for free.** Go to: <https://www.crowdrise.com/Challenge-FreeAlternateMethodofEntry> and follow the on-screen instructions to submit a "Free Alternate Method of Entry" form. The name of the Promotion is "*Give Twin Cities Bonus Challenge Six*". Your form must be submitted and received during the Entry Period and must be complete and accurate, or your entry is automatically void.

### **Limits:**

Grand prize winners are **not** eligible to participate and win.

One entry and Prize per organization. Odds of winning in this Bonus Challenge depend on the number of Eligible Organizations who enter as described above.

Restrictions Apply (in Section 5 below).

## **5. GENERAL RESTRICTIONS AND DONATION RESTRICTIONS:**

Potential Winners are not declared final and shall not receive a Prize until verified by Sponsors per Section 8 herein.

Regardless of the Bonus Challenge or method of entry, all entries, donations, and other actions are subject to verification of eligibility before a prize or Challenge Grant can be awarded.

The minimum donation is \$10 and the maximum donation is \$10,000 per transaction. Donations must be made on the Website via the Campaign page using a credit card through CrowdRise and its third party payment processor during the Challenge Period to count toward the Challenge. Donations made outside of the Challenge, outside the Challenge Period and/or offline, even if recorded on the Website, including, but not limited to, donations by cash, credit card, money order, donations made to an Organization's non-Challenge website or an ineligible fundraising page on CrowdRise.com, or any other donations not successfully processed online via credit card ("offline donations") are not eligible and will not be counted toward the Challenge.

**Donations can take time to process.** All donations must be successfully processed to completion through CrowdRise and its third party payment processor(s) **before** the end of the Challenge Period and applicable Bonus Challenge Periods (see below for "How to Enter" each Bonus Challenge) in order to count toward the total amounts raised for the applicable Campaign. CrowdRise has the right to verify any such donation, and any such donation that is subject to chargeback or dispute may not count toward the total amount raised. Neither Sponsor nor CrowdRise is responsible for any delays in processing any donations. The list of donations on any particular Campaign page, if any is displaying or any similar tally of donation(s), are

unofficial tallies of the amounts of donations in a Campaign and may not accurately reflect the donations made based on a variety of factors. Results of the Challenge are not official until Sponsor and/or CrowdRise, or their respective duly authorized representatives, verify the winner(s).

An entrant or its proxy may not donate any money to its own Campaign page that would be counted towards its donations for the Challenge, whether by taking money from its own account(s) to donate to itself or otherwise, no matter the intent. This includes, without limitation, receiving cash or check donations or having an employee, Board Member, or other individual act as a proxy for the Entrant; such proxy donations do not count. Donations may not be transferred from another fundraising page on the Website to your Campaign page.

Charitable tax receipts will not be issued to all donors. Donations may not be tax-deductible and the winner(s)'s prize may be taxable. It is the individual donor's sole responsibility to determine the tax-consequences of their donations. Every donor and Eligible Organization agrees that information provided by Sponsor or CrowdRise is not advice, including but not limited to, tax advice or legal advice, and every person and entity is advised to consult a professional, including a tax professional.

Those entrants who do not provide the required information in their donation or entry form, or abide by these Official Rules or other instructions of Sponsor, CrowdRise or Prize Provider may be disqualified at Sponsor's, CrowdRise's or Prize Provider's sole and absolute discretion. All entries that are late, illegible, incomplete, damaged, destroyed, forged or otherwise not in compliance with the Official Rules may be disqualified from the Promotion at Sponsor's, CrowdRise's or Prize Provider's sole and absolute discretion.

In the event of a dispute as to the identity of any entrant, Potential Winner(s) may be required to show proof of being the registered account holder. If a dispute cannot be resolved to the Sponsor's, CrowdRise's and Prize Provider's satisfaction, the entry will be deemed ineligible.

Your participation in the Promotion is voluntary and does not require you to purchase anything from the Sponsor, CrowdRise or Prize Provider.

Any Eligible Organization or Representative who does not follow all of the restrictions, requirements, provide the required information, or abide by these Official Rules and the Official Challenge Rules or other instructions of Sponsors', may be disqualified at Sponsors' sole and absolute discretion. All required information that is late, illegible, incomplete, damaged, destroyed, forged or otherwise not in compliance with these Official Rules and the Official Challenge Rules may result in an Eligible Organization being disqualified from the applicable Bonus Challenge at Sponsor's sole and absolute discretion.

Any individual donor or Representative, and any Eligible Organization, may be required to show proof of identity and Representatives may be required to show proof of authority to agree to bind the Eligible Organization to these Official Rules and the Challenge Rules and CrowdRise Terms. If a dispute cannot be resolved to the Sponsors' and Administrator's satisfaction, the affected entry or Eligible Organization will be deemed ineligible. Sponsors and Administrator are not responsible for lost, misdirected, misplaced, stolen, tampered with, deleted, or invalid fundraising pages, team pages, donations, refunds or chargebacks on the Campaign Page.

All donations made in connection with the Challenge are governed by the Challenge Rules and CrowdRise Terms. Donors may make eligible donations to an Eligible Organization via the Website at any time during the Entry Period for an applicable Bonus Challenge per Rule 3 above. The following restrictions govern donations and Eligible Organizations agree that any determination by Sponsors or Administrator as to whether a donation complies with these restrictions and requirements shall be final and binding.

- a. The minimum donation is ten dollars (\$10).
- b. Limit of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) per transaction.
- c. Donations must be made on the Website using a credit card and successfully processed to completion (and not subject to any chargebacks or disputes) through CrowdRise and its third party payment processor during the Promotion Period to count toward the Promotion.

Donations made outside of the Entry Period and/or offline, even if recorded on the Website are not eligible and will not be counted. Assurance of delivery and processing of donations is the sole responsibility of the entrant. Donations are non-refundable. Please note that although you may receive entries for the full amount of your eligible donation in accordance with the terms in these Official Rules, the ultimate recipient of your donation (the organization) may receive less than the full amount that you donate after the deduction of administrative and processing fees in accordance with the CrowdRise Terms and Conditions.

- d. An Organization or its proxy may not donate any money to its own Campaign Page that would be counted towards its donations for the Challenge, whether by taking money from its own account(s) to donate to itself or otherwise, no matter the intent. This includes, without limitation, receiving cash or check donations or having an employee, Board Member, the Applicant, or other individual act as a proxy for the Organization; such proxy donations do not count.

## 6. PRIZES FOR EACH BONUS CHALLENGE:

**Bonus Challenge One:** As set forth above, there will be two (2) winners, each of who will receive a Challenge Grant in the amount of five hundred dollars (\$500) made payable by check. The Approximate Retail Value (“ARV”) of all Prizes: one thousand dollars (\$1,000).

**Bonus Challenge Two:** As set forth above, there will be one (1) winner, who will receive a Challenge Grant in the amount of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) made payable by check. The Approximate Retail Value (“ARV”) of the Prize: one thousand dollars (\$1,000).

**Bonus Challenge Three Sweepstakes:** As set forth above, there will be one (1) winner, who will receive a Challenge Grant in the amount of seven hundred dollars (\$700) made payable by check. The Approximate Retail Value (“ARV”) of the Prize: seven hundred dollars (\$700).

**Bonus Challenge Three Contest:** As set forth above, there will be one (1) winner, who will receive a Challenge Grant in the amount of three hundred dollars (\$300) made payable by check. The Approximate Retail Value (“ARV”) of the Prize: three hundred dollars (\$300).

**Bonus Challenge Four:** As set forth above, there will be two (2) winners, each of who will receive a Challenge Grant in the amount of either three hundred dollars (\$300) made payable by check. The Approximate Retail Value (“ARV”) of all Prizes: one thousand dollars (\$1,000). One of the winners will receive a Bonus Challenge Grant in the amount of four hundred dollars (\$400) made payable by check.

**Bonus Challenge Five:** As set forth above, there will be two (2) winners, each of who will receive a Challenge Grant in the amount of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250) made payable by check. The Approximate Retail Value (“ARV”) of all Prizes: five hundred dollars (\$500).

**Bonus Challenge Six:** As set forth above, there will be one (1) winner, who will receive a Challenge Grant in the amount of five hundred dollars (\$500) made payable by check. The Approximate Retail Value (“ARV”) of the Prize: five hundred dollars (\$500).

The Challenge Grants are non-transferable by the winner(s). All prize details not specified in these Official Rules will be determined in Prize Provider’s sole and absolute discretion. Winner(s) will be solely responsible for all federal, state and/or local taxes, and for any other fees or costs associated with the prizes they receive, regardless of whether it, in whole or in part, are used.

The prize will be sent by check and will only be to the verified winner’s physical mailing address (no P.O. Boxes). Neither Sponsor nor CrowdRise are responsible for lost or stolen checks during shipping or anytime thereafter. Shipping date within seventy-five (75) days after the winner has been verified as eligible to participate and win and the exact date is to be determined by Sponsor. The prize is non-transferable by the



winners. All prize details not specified in these Official Rules will be determined in Sponsor's sole and absolute discretion. Winner(s) will be solely responsible for all federal, state and/or local taxes and for any other fees or costs associated with the prizes they receive, if any.

## **7. SELECTION OF WINNERS FOR EACH BONUS CHALLENGE AND ODDS OF WINNING:**

You expressly waive and release any right or benefit which you have or may have under Section 1542 of the Civil Code of the State of California, to the full extent that you may waive all such rights and benefits pertaining to the matters released here. In connection with such waiver and relinquishment, you acknowledge that you are aware that you may hereafter discover claims presently unknown or unsuspected, or facts in addition to or different from those which you now know or believe to be true, with respect to the matters released herein; nevertheless, it is your intention through this release to fully and finally and forever settle and release all such matters and claims relative thereto, which do not exist, may exist or heretofore have existed between yourself and the Sponsor related to the Promotion. The release herein given shall be and remain in effect as a full and complete release of such claims and matters notwithstanding the discovery or existence of any such additional or different claims or facts relative thereto.**

**10. ARBITRATION AGREEMENT; DISPUTE RESOLUTION BY BINDING ARBITRATION:**

**PLEASE READ THIS SECTION CAREFULLY AS IT AFFECTS YOUR RIGHTS.**

(a) Agreement to Arbitrate: This Section is referred to in these Official Rules as the "Arbitration Agreement." You agree that any and all disputes or claims that have arisen or may arise between you and CrowdRise or Sponsor, whether arising out of or relating to these Official Rules, the Promotion, your participation in the Promotion, the prize, acceptance, possession, use or misuse of the prize, any advertising, or any aspect of the relationship between us, shall be resolved exclusively through final and binding arbitration, rather than a court, in accordance with the terms of this Arbitration Agreement, except that you may assert individual claims in small claims court, if your claims qualify. ***OTHER ONLY ON AN INDIVIDUAL BASIS AND NOT AS A PLAINTIFF OR CLASS MEMBER IN ANY PURPORTED CLASS OR REPRESENTATIVE ACTION OR PROCEEDING. UNLESS BOTH YOU AND CROWDRISE AND SPONSOR, AS APPLICABLE, AGREE OTHERWISE, THE ARBITRATOR MAY NOT CONSOLIDATE OR JOIN MORE THAN ONE PERSON'S OR PARTY'S CLAIMS AND MAY NOT OTHERWISE PRESIDE OVER ANY FORM OF A CONSOLIDATED, REPRESENTATIVE, OR CLASS PROCEEDING. ALSO, THE ARBITRATOR MAY AWARD RELIEF (INCLUDING MONETARY, INJUNCTIVE, AND DECLARATORY RELIEF) ONLY IN FAVOR OF THE INDIVIDUAL PARTY SEEKING RELIEF AND ONLY TO THE EXTENT NECESSARY TO PROVIDE RELIEF NECESSITATED BY THAT PARTY'S INDIVIDUAL CLAIM(S).***

(c) **Pre-Arbitration Dispute Resolution:** CrowdRise and Sponsor are always interested in resolving disputes amicably and efficiently, and most participant concerns can be resolved quickly and to the participant's satisfaction by emailing Sponsor's support team at [Felix@CrowdRise.com](mailto:Felix@CrowdRise.com). If such efforts prove unsuccessful, a party who intends to seek arbitration must first send to the other, by certified mail, a written Notice of Dispute ("**Notice**"). The Notice to the Sponsor should be sent to GoFundMe, Inc., Attn: Robin Wolfe, 855 Jefferson Avenue, Redwood City, CA 94063 ("**Notice Address**"). The Notice must (i) describe the nature and basis of the claim or dispute and (ii) set forth the specific relief sought. If CrowdRise and/or Sponsor, as applicable, and you do not resolve the claim within sixty (60) calendar days after the Notice is received, you, CrowdRise or Sponsor may commence an arbitration proceeding. During the arbitration, the amount of any settlement offer made by CrowdRise, Sponsor or you shall not be disclosed to the arbitrator until after the arbitrator determines the amount, if any, to which you, CrowdRise or Sponsor is entitled.

(d) **Arbitration Procedures:** Arbitration will be conducted by a neutral arbitrator in accordance with the American Arbitration Association's ("**AAA**") rules and procedures, including the AAA's Supplementary Procedures for Consumer-Related Disputes (collectively, the "**AAA Rules**"), as modified by this Arbitration Agreement. For information on the AAA, please visit its website, <http://www.adr.org>. Information about the AAA Rules and fees for consumer disputes can be found at the AAA's consumer arbitration page, [http://www.adr.org/consumer\\_arbitration](http://www.adr.org/consumer_arbitration). If there is any inconsistency between any term of the AAA Rules and any term of this Arbitration Agreement, the applicable terms of this Arbitration Agreement will control unless the arbitrator determines that the application of the inconsistent Arbitration Agreement terms would not result in a fundamentally fair arbitration. The arbitrator must also follow the provisions of these Official Rules as a court would. All issues are for the arbitrator to decide, including, but not limited to, issues relating to the scope, enforceability, and arbitrability of this Arbitration Agreement. Although arbitration proceedings are usually simpler and more streamlined than trials and other judicial proceedings, the arbitrator can award the same damages and relief on an individual basis that a court can award to an individual under these Official Rules and applicable law. Decisions by the arbitrator are enforceable in court and may be overturned by a court only for very limited reasons.

Unless CrowdRise and/or Sponsor, as applicable, and you agree otherwise, any arbitration hearings will take place in a reasonably convenient location for both parties with due consideration of their ability to travel and other pertinent circumstances. If the parties are unable to agree on a location, the determination shall be made by AAA. If your claim is for \$10,000 or less, CrowdRise and/or Sponsor agrees that you may choose whether the arbitration will be conducted solely on the basis of documents submitted to the arbitrator, through a telephonic hearing or by an in-person hearing as established by the AAA Rules. If your claim exceeds \$10,000, the right to a hearing will be determined by the AAA Rules. Regardless of the manner in which the arbitration is conducted, the arbitrator shall issue a reasoned written decision sufficient to explain the essential findings and conclusions on which the award is based.

(e) **Costs of Arbitration:** Payment of all filing, administration, and arbitrator fees (collectively, the "**Arbitration Fees**") will be governed by the AAA Rules, unless otherwise provided in this Arbitration Agreement. Any payment of attorneys' fees will be governed by the AAA Rules.

(f) **Confidentiality:** All aspects of the arbitration proceeding, and any ruling, decision, or award by the arbitrator, will be strictly confidential for the benefit of all parties.

(g) **Severability:** If a court or the arbitrator decides that any term or provision of this Arbitration Agreement other than clause (b) above is invalid or unenforceable, the parties agree to replace such term or provision with a term or provision that is valid and enforceable and that comes closest to expressing the intention of the invalid or unenforceable term or provision, and this Arbitration Agreement shall be enforceable as so modified. If a court or the arbitrator decides that any of the provisions of clause (b) is invalid or unenforceable, then the entirety of this Arbitration Agreement shall be null and void. The remainder of these Official Rules will continue to apply.

(h) **Conflict:** In the event of any conflict between any term or condition in this Section 10 and any term or condition in the CrowdRise Terms and Conditions (<https://www.crowdrise.com/about/terms>), then the applicable term or condition in this Section 10 shall apply.

**11. ENTRANT'S PERSONAL INFORMATION:** By entering the Challenge, entrants/representatives consent to the collection, use and disclosure of its/their personal information for the purpose of administering the Challenge and prize fulfillment. Entrants and their representatives may also have the opportunity to sign up to receive promotional emails from parties associated with the Challenge; the choice to consent to such emails or to opt out of such emails in future does not impact organizations' chances of winning.
